Regulations and Principles to be Applied at the Entrance

#### MUSEUM TICKET PRICES:

#### For Turkish Citizens:

- Full: 160 TL

- Discounted: 80 TL

### For Non-Turkish Citizens:

- Full: 450 TL

#### **Discounted Ticket Categories:**

- Students over the age of 18, MSGSU alumni, academic staff
- Group discount: 20% (for purchases of 10 tickets or more in one transaction)

## The following categories have free admission:

- Turkish citizens aged 65 and over,
- Veterans, spouses and children of martyrs and veterans,
- Disabled individuals with one companion,
- Teachers working in primary, secondary, and high schools affiliated with the Ministry of National Education.
- Conscripts (privates and non-commissioned officers),
- Holders of AICA, UPSD, AIAP, ICOM, ICOMOS, UNESCO cards, and press ID cards, as well as COCART guide card holders,
- Children between 0-18 years old.

#### MUSEUM ENTRANCE INFORMATION:

- Monday: Closed
- Tuesday: Open between 10:00 20:00
- Other days: Open between 10:00 17:00
- Last admission: 19:30 on Tuesdays, 16:30 on other days.
- Closed on the first day of religious holidays and January 1st each year.

With the recommendation of the Museum Directorate and the approval of the Rectorate, it is possible to open the museum to visitors outside official hours and on closed days, provided that double the highest admission fee per person is charged and at least 25 participants per hour are accepted, in groups of maximum 15 people. Accompanying individuals who already qualify for free admission are not included in this count.

- Cash is not accepted at the museum entrance. The only payment method is Credit/Debit

cards supported by the museum's POS devices.

- Museum staff are strictly prohibited from accepting cash from visitors or using their personal cards for visitor entry.
- Foreign students with Turkish residence permits and presenting a Turkish university card can benefit from Turkish citizen discounts. If studying abroad, they pay half the non-citizen fee.
- Foreign residents with residence permits pay the Turkish citizen fee.
- Foreign citizens over 65 years old pay the non-citizen fee, unless they have a residence permit, in which case they enter free.
- Teachers, including private school and retired teachers, enter free with an official Ministry of Education ID.
- MSGSU staff, students, and employees enter free.
- "Museum Pass" is not valid.
- On Tuesdays between 16:00 20:00, all students (both Turkish and foreign) enter free.
- Employees of sponsor companies on organized tours enter free.

# LIQUIDS AND AEROSOLS:

Bringing liquids, food, or aerosols into the museum, whether carried on the person or in bags, is prohibited. Examples:

- Water
- Perfume
- Deodorant
- Cologne

## Exceptions for liquids:

- Baby bottles,
- Patients with medical conditions (e.g., salivary gland or serious illness) or individuals over 65 years old may bring water, provided it is handed to security personnel and consumed only when needed. Carrying water inside the exhibition halls is strictly prohibited.

#### **UMBRELLAS AND BACKPACKS:**

- Umbrellas are not allowed inside, regardless of being wet or carried in a bag.
- Backpacks will be left in the cloakroom due to the risk of damaging artworks. Small bags may be carried by hand or worn in front.

#### GENERAL RULES TO BE OBSERVED:

- Pets, even in cages, are prohibited.
- Entry with scooters, skates, or skateboards is prohibited.
- Touching or getting too close to artworks is prohibited.
- Flash photography is prohibited.
- Smoking or use of any tobacco-related products, including e-cigarettes, is prohibited inside the museum.
- Visitors disturbing others with loud talking or inappropriate behavior will be warned by

security. Failure to comply may result in removal according to security procedures.
